



EDMONTON MUSIC PRIZE 2022 FAQ

1. Do I have to be an Alberta Music member to apply?

No, you do not have to be a member to apply.

2. Do I have to be an established artist to apply?

Emerging and established artists are encouraged to apply, as long as the artistic work is of high quality.

3. What is considered a unique contribution, or accomplishment in music?

This can include community involvement, charity work, collaborations, or any way you have contributed to the community in Edmonton.

4. Who can nominate me as an artist?

Anyone can nominate you! This can be a family member, friend, manager, coworker, you name it! It is important that whoever nominates you has the ability to express why you would be a good candidate. Nominations must be approved by the artist.

5. Can I nominate myself?

You cannot nominate yourself.

6. Do I have to reside in Edmonton to be eligible for this opportunity?

Nominees must be an adult (18+) resident of Edmonton or surrounding area for at least one year, and in the case of collectives, the majority of members must be from Edmonton or surrounding area. "Surrounding area" includes Leduc County, Parkland County, Strathcona County, and Sturgeon counties and nearby Indigenous communities, commonly called the "Greater Edmonton Region " as defined by the Edmonton Community Foundation.

7. How many letters of support do I need to submit?

A minimum of 1 and maximum of 3 letters of support must be submitted with the application.
